If you live in a **low- or moderate-income household** and think that you may have property with unclear title in New Orleans, call Southeast Louisiana Legal Services at **(504) 529-1000**. We will determine whether you are eligible for free legal assistance. If you are eligible, we will assign an attorney to your case to help you clear title to your home.

Almost six years after Hurricane Katrina, many people who own property in New Orleans and live in other states have not been able to make necessary repairs and return to their homes because they do not have clear title to their land. Without clear ownership, homeowners are unable to access the recovery grants and loans they need to repair and return to their homes.
